Material Designated for Recycling

Pursuant to Section 350-3(C) of the County Flow Control Law, Chapter 350 of the Laws of Rockland County, the Rockland County Solid Waste Management Authority designates the following materials to be separated from the waste stream to be recycled:

I. Mixed Paper

- Newspapers (including inserts)
- Direct mail (junk mail)
- Envelopes
- Cardboard (smooth and corrugated)
- Office paper
- Construction paper
- Computer/Fax paper
- Magazines
- Catalogs
- Workbooks
- Telephone books
- Paperback books
- Brown grocery bags

II. Commingled Containers

- Plastic containers with recycling code 1-7 (no styrofoam or plastic bags)
- Aluminum cans
- Aluminum foil
- Disposable aluminum products
- Metal cans
- Aerosol cans (empty)
- Glass containers -- clear, green, brown

III. Yard Waste

- Brush
- Grass clippings
- Leaves

IV. Scrap Metal

- White goods (stoves, refrigerators, washing machines, dishwashers, and hot water heaters)
- Metal furniture

Uncontaminated metal vehicle parts (excluding mufflers and catalytic converters and parts that contain fluids or motor oil)

Metal pipes

Bed frames

Metal sheds
