TEFRA NOTICE

The Rockland County Solid Waste Management Authority (the "Authority") has the power, pursuant to Title 13-M of the New York State Public Authorities Law, to issue tax-exempt and taxable bonds and notes to finance solid waste management projects in accordance with the approved Rockland County Solid Waste Management Plan, including facilities for solid waste disposal activities. The Authority intends to issue obligations pursuant to a plan of financing, in a maximum aggregate principal amount at any one time outstanding not to exceed \$2.5 million ("Notes"), for the purpose of financing or refinancing a portion of the costs of acquiring, planning, designing, constructing, equipping, improving and installing certain solid waste disposal facilities ("Project") and the funding of a debt service reserve fund, costs of issuance and credit enhancement (if any) with respect to the Notes.

Project:

The Project consists of certain facilities to be owned by the Authority and operated by a private vendor selected by the Authority for solid waste disposal activities within the County of Rockland in New York State. The Project includes all or a portion of the acquisition, planning, design, construction, equipping, improving and installing of the following facilities:

The Transfer Station is located at 60 Baler Boulevard, Hillburn, New York 10931. The Transfer Station is located on an approximately nine acre site located in the Torne Valley, in the Town of Ramapo in Rockland County, New York. Such site is a portion of the Authority's approximately forty seven acre site located within the Torne Valley. The Transfer Station consists of an approximately 21,600 square feet building with associated equipment for municipal solid waste transfer activities, including weight scale and scalehouse. Improvements to the Transfer Station will include a pre-processing facility which is being constructed to assist in the removal of recyclable materials from the municipal solid waste stream.

Hearing:

A public hearing will be held on January 14, 2002, commencing at 11:00 a.m. at the Authority offices, 420 Torne Valley Road, Hillburn, New York 10931, for the purpose of hearing the views of interested members of the public concerning issuance of the Bonds. Notice of the public hearing is

being published pursuant to the requirements of Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.

Interested parties are invited to submit written comments, speak at the public hearing, or both. Written comments must be received by the Authority no later than 4:00 p.m. on January 11, 2002, by mail or hand delivery to Ronald C. Delo, P.E., Executive Director of the Authority, at the address below, unless submitted by hand delivery to the presiding official at the public hearing.
